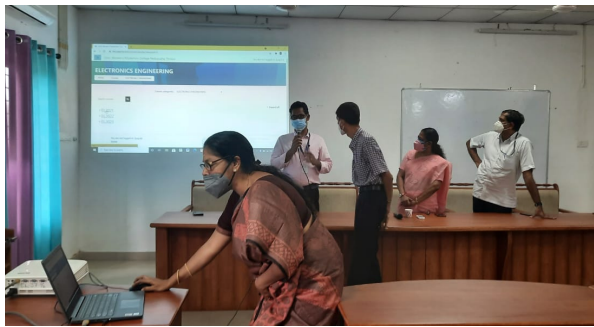

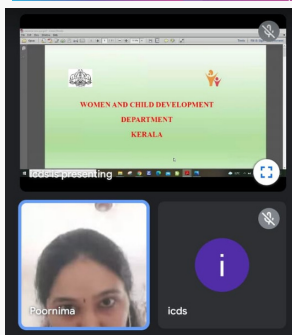
COVID VACCINE AWARENESS RALLY

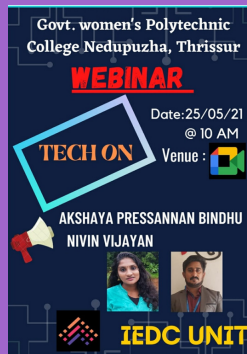


WORLD BLOOD DONOR DAY

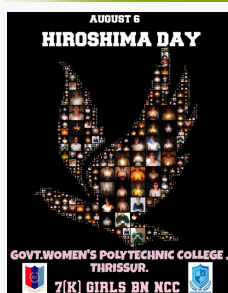
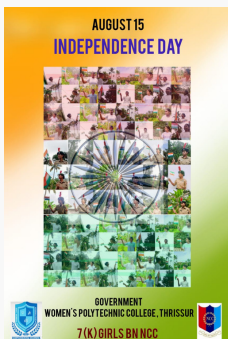
TREE SAPPLINGS CHALLENGE
